The Two-Day International Multidisciplinary Conference on "Navigating the Nexus: FinTech Innovation, Digital Transformation, Sustainability, and Society in a Globalized World" was successfully organized by B.M.S. College for Women, Bengaluru, India, in collaboration with the International Council for Education Research and Training (ICERT) Pennsylvania USA and India on March 04-05, 2026. The event was held to commemorate International Women's Day and the World Day of Social Justice, drawing significant global interest with a total of 462 registrations. This included 353 registrations from India and 109 foreign registrations from countries such as Nigeria, Bangladesh, Ghana, South Korea, US, UK and Ethiopia, highlighting the conference's wide international reach.

The proceedings were anchored and coordinated by Dr. Neethu G S (HOD & Associate Professor, Librarian) and Dr. Mamatha D (HOD & Assistant Professor, Department of Business Administration) from B.M.S. College for Women. The formal program commenced with a Welcome Address by Dr. N. Raghu Kumara, Principal of B.M.S. College for Women, followed by the introduction of the dignitaries, including Chief Patron Dr. B.S. Ragini Narayan and Guest of Honor Dr. P. Dayananda Pai. Dr. Vijayalakshmi S. served as the Convenor for the event.



The intellectual foundation of the conference was set during the Inauguration and Keynote Session, featuring distinguished global speakers. A powerful Keynote Address was delivered by Dr. Marina Arnaut from the Dubai

Business School, University of Dubai. Further academic perspectives were shared through addresses by Dr. Navneet Kaur (Director, ICERT-Sophia), Dr. Amila Gamage (LIGS University, USA), and Prof. (Dr.) Ananda Suryanarayana (College of Banking and Financial Studies, Oman). Additional insights were provided by Prof. (Dr.) Aruna Anchal (Baba Mastnath University & Director, ICERT-Sapientia) and Chief Guest Dr. Pradeep Ramavath J from the Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS).

The conference featured seven technical sessions over two days, presided over by expert chairpersons and coordinators. On the first day, physical and online sessions were chaired by Dr. Venkata Ramu B.R., Dr. Krishana Naik, and Dr. Swarna, with coordination support from Mrs. Nandini J, Prof. Ramya P, Dr Megha L.M., Dr Manasa A.M. and Mrs. Puspa Mondal. The second day, held entirely online, was chaired by Prof. (Dr.) Nilam Panchal, Dr. Priyanka Singla, Dr. N. Nazini, and Dr. Blessing Agbo. These sessions were coordinated by Dr. Preeti Singhwal, Ms. Soniya Joseph, Ms. Gillella Vedavati, and Ms. Vandita Sharma. The event also featured the release of the Conference Souvenir and the prestigious declaration of the "Baba Saheb Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Excellence Award 2026" to 11 dignitaries and the "Global Women Icon Award 2026" to 11 to most dedicated women educators.

The conference concluded with traditional dance performance by BMS College Students and formal vote of thank by conference coordinators.
