
Distinguished Addresses:

IMPORTANT SECTIONS

- Section 3 says that no person without the previous approval of the National Biodiversity Authority shall obtain any biological resources occurring in India or knowledge associated thereto for research or for commercial utilization or for bio-survey and bio-utilization
- The person who shall be required to seek approval are
 - a person who is not a citizen of India
 - a citizen of India who is non-resident as defined in Clause 30 of Section 2 of Income Tax Act 1961,
 - a body corporate association or organization which is not incorporated or registered in India or incorporated or registered in India under any law for the time being in force which has any non-Indian participation in its share
- Section 6 says application for intellectual property rights not to be made without prior approval of National Biodiversity Authority
