#### **Executive Summary: International Conference on Reimagining Knowledge Systems**

The International Council for Education, Research and Training (ICERT), in collaboration with I.N.M. PG College, Meerut, successfully organized a two-day international conference. Centered on the theme of bridging indigenous wisdom with modern multidisciplinary research, the event served as a global platform for scholars and educators. The conference witnessed robust global participation, with 307 delegates from 13 regions, including India, Nigeria, Malaysia, USA, Philippines, Singapore, Kosovo, Ethiopia, UK, Nepal, Dubai, UAE, and Egypt.

**Inaugural & Plenary Highlights** The conference was formally inaugurated by Prof. (Dr.) Sandeep Kumar, President of ICERT, and Sh. Arun Gupta, Secretary of I.N.M. PG College.

- **Special Address:** Dr. Ravinder Kumar explored the Indian Knowledge System, drawing profound connections between ancient texts like the Vedas and the Mahabharat, and contemporary research methodologies.

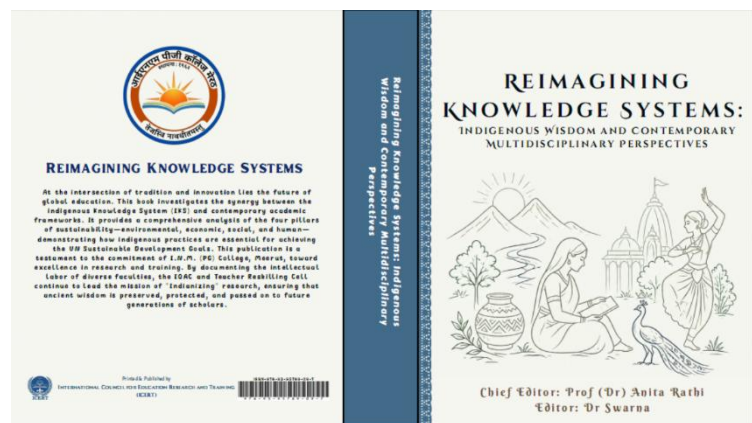
