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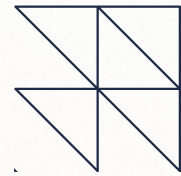
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ABOUT ICERT

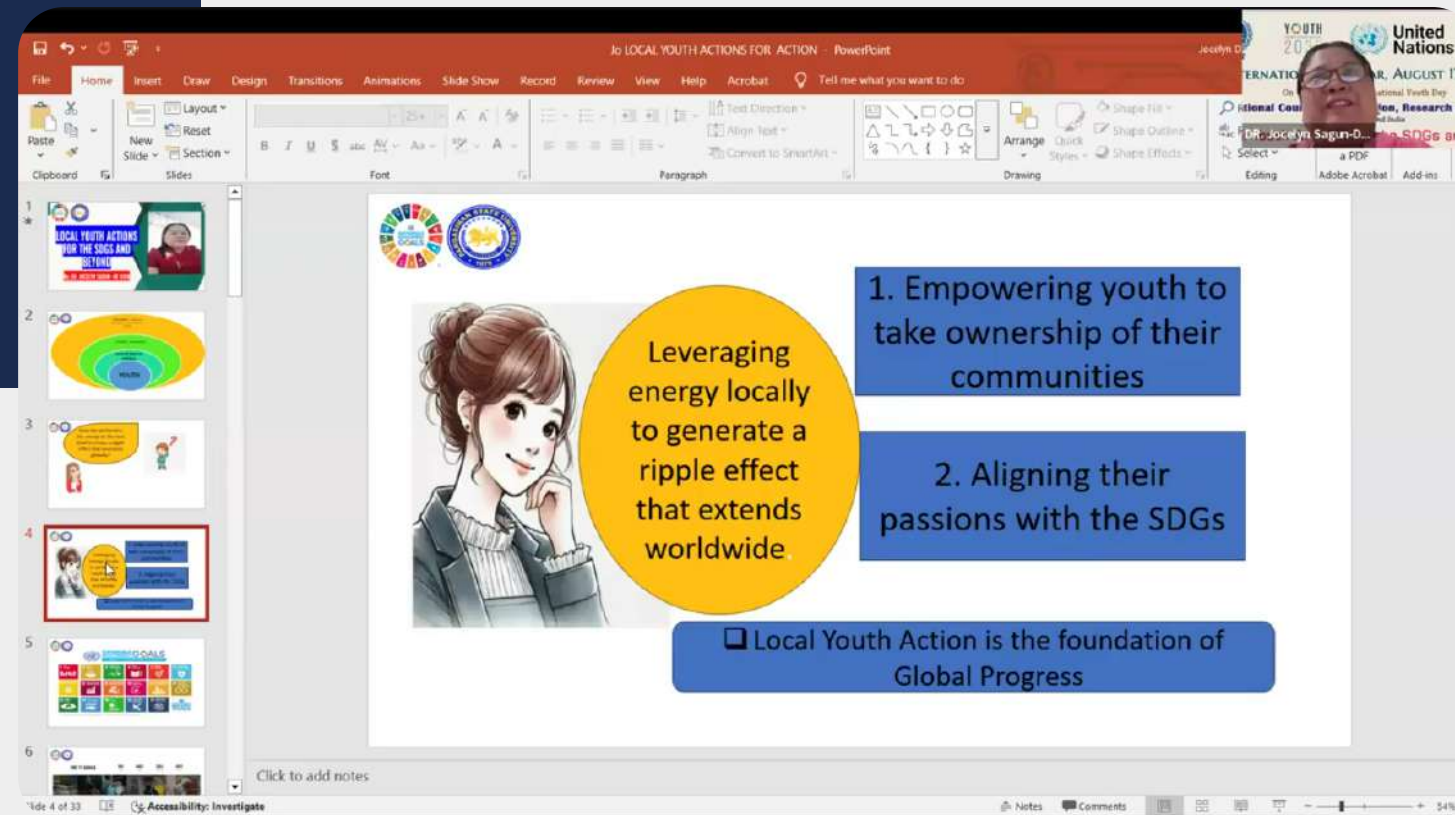

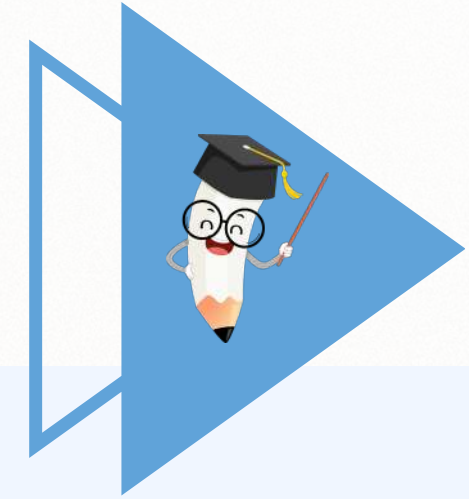
UN International Women's Day Seminar

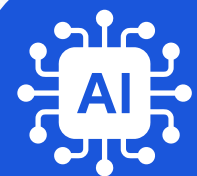


World Teachers' Day 2025 International Seminar:
